

General Information

By registering for classes at Howard University, a student agrees to assume financial responsibility for all charges billed to their student account including, but not limited to: tuition, fees, housing, meals, books, health insurance, returned checks, parking and library fines.

It is important to note that tuition and fees vary by school, college, and level. Furthermore, tuition and fees, housing, and meal charges are assessed each semester. Housing and meal plan charges are based on the type of room or meal plan selected. (Consult the housing and meal plan contracts for the exact amount due).

Payments may be made via credit card (Visa, American Express, Master Card, and Discover), cash, money order and/or certified check. A \$35.00 fee will be charged for all reversed credit card payments and returned checks; subsequent checks will not be accepted.

Howard sends a monthly electronic billing statement to each student while the student has an account balance. A student may view his/her e-bill via BisonWeb. It is the student's responsibility to pay tuition, fees and housing by the published due date whether he/she receives a bill or not.

Withdrawal Deadlines

Students registering for classes incur a financial obligation to the University. If you will not be attending in the semester for which you registered, you must drop your classes by the 100% adjustment period deadline. Otherwise, you will be responsible for all or a portion of your registration charges (tuition, fees, housing and meals). **Students enrolled in courses that carry zero academic credit must pay for a minimum of one (1) financial hour.**

Students who officially withdraw, are suspended, drop or decrease their program after the first day of instruction may expect to have charges for tuition and fees adjusted or prorated as follows:

Fall or Spring Semester

100% 1st Day of Instruction thru 7th Calendar Day
50% 8th Calendar Day thru 40th Calendar Day
25% 41st Calendar Day thru 60th Calendar Day
0% 61st Calendar Day thru Last Day of Semester

Summer Semester:

100% 1st Day of Instruction
50% 2nd Calendar Day thru 6th Calendar Day
25% 7th Calendar Day thru 11th Calendar Day
0% 12th Calendar Day thru Last Day of Semester

Explanation of Fees

Matriculation Fee - includes student activities and on campus health services and benefits.

Self Help Fee - Student voted fee to establish the student Self Help Emergency Loan Fund and available to all currently enrolled students.

Dependent upon the school and the courses in which a student is enrolled, additional fees may be incurred. You will be notified of exact fee charges upon registration.

A \$100.00 late payment fee is assessed monthly on any outstanding balance until it is paid-in-full.
